In February two cannabis factories were discovered on our wards, one of the properties was an abandoned detached house and inside the building was an abandoned cannabis factory. Officers received this intelligence and worked together with the help of our sister teams KENLEY, OLD COULSDON and COULSDON TOWN. We engaged with the landlord to secure this property.

Purley and Woodcote SNT have been planning for the year ahead, we have created our events calendar, giving our best efforts to attend the events on our wards and engage with our local residents. We have also planned some events that will be hosted by us which will be advertised on our newsletters, social media and via emails. These events include catalytic converter marking and crime prevention stalls.

We have engaged in training aimed at shoplifting and how to tackle prolific offenders. This has equipped us with tools and skills so that we can help our local businesses and we plan to work together to tackle these issues in the future.

We hope to meet with the businesses soon to discuss. Finally, the team have been doing some reassurance/ anti-social-behaviour patrols in and around Purley and Woodcote High Street and will continue these throughout the year to ensure we are a visible presence in the community.
